


**Problem:** 77% of children in Chicago from low-income households start kindergarten behind, and many never catch up

**Root cause:** Serial underinvestment (especially in Black and Brown communities) in the adults who matter most to children's early brain development

**Opportunity:** Provide parents, caregivers, and educators with tools and support to help young children thrive before they enter kindergarten, in the years when 90% of brain development happens

Serving 39 under-resourced schools and communities throughout Chicago





All adults can help young children thrive if they have access to knowledge, tools, and the resilience that comes from a community of peers.




#### GOAL: Children thrive in school and become the future leaders we need

# **Our Portfolio of Programs**

VOCEL's programming and partnerships support schools and families in overburdened, under-resourced communities throughout Chicago. Guided by brain science, we work with parents, caregivers, and educators to create environments where children have high levels of emotional support; many opportunities to experiment, be creative, and own their learning; and frequent and robust communication with adults and other children.

## The Child Parent Academy

VOCEL'S flagship program is a dynamic, twogeneration early learning accelerator where children aged o-4 years and their parents learn side-by-side. Sessions meet weekly at schools on Chicago's West, Southwest, and South Sides. (During COVID-19, all programming is accessible through virtual platforms.)



### **Powered by VOCEL**

To leverage the talent that already exists in each school community, VOCEL is equipping parents at select CPS elementary schools to implement the Child Parent Academy for their peers with coaching and support from our expert staff.



**Early Educators for Thriving Children (EETC)** 

EETC provides training, coaching, and a community of peer support to help preschool and kindergarten teachers meet their students' mental health needs amidst the return to in-person learning.

## **Building Early Learning Leaders (BELL)**

Just as children should prepare for school, schools must prepare for young children. That's why VOCEL has partnered with the Education Equity Fund to provide group training and individualized coaching to a cohort of Chicago Public Schools leaders to shape their vision for early learning excellence.
